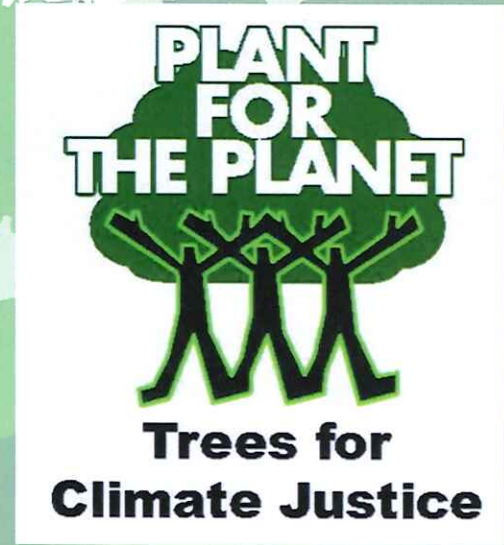

Founded in 2007 by nine year old Felix Finkbeiner, Plant for the Planet empowers 30,000+ children worldwide to battle climate change with science, leadership, and planting trees.



The ultimate goal:
Plant 1 trillion trees worldwide by 2020.
150 trees per person on Earth.

Seattle's fair share based on population comes to **95 million** trees, **100 x** more than will ever fit. We donate to reforest the tropics where trees grow year-round.

Plant for the Planet Seattle was established in 2013 by Michael Foster. Currently, Puget Sound is the most active location in the USA.

50,913 square miles of forest are destroyed each year.



Since 2013, Plant for the Planet volunteers have led several Academies inspiring children to serve the Pacific Northwest as Ambassadors for Climate Justice.
