Subject: Foss lease at Terminal 5 3/10/15

My name is Lisa Marcus. I'm a resident of Seattle and a health care practitioner and mother. I spend a large portion of my time volunteering to organize ~~for~~ ^{sustainable} solutions and to end our dependence on fossil fuels before we reach the catastrophic tipping point where global warming can no longer be brought under control. The science is clear that all new oil extraction must stop immediately, and what is referred to as extreme fossil fuel development including arctic drilling must completely cease. We simply can not be any part of the criminal activity that supports corporate money making at the expense of humanity. People in Seattle support the Port's stated goals of being a leader "where a sustainable world is headed."

This lease with Foss (and through Foss with Shell) is a mistake.
