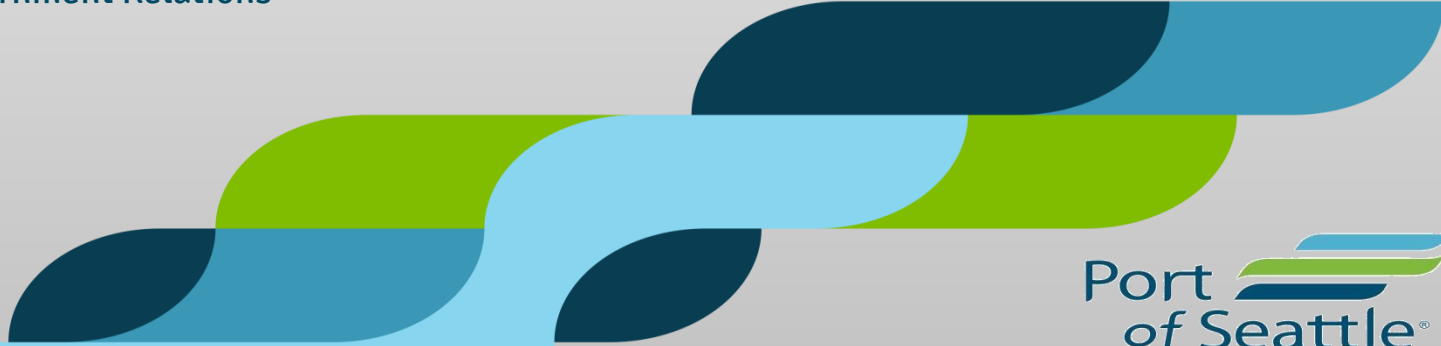

- Identified grant processes used elsewhere.
- Received community input.
- Held four Internal meetings.

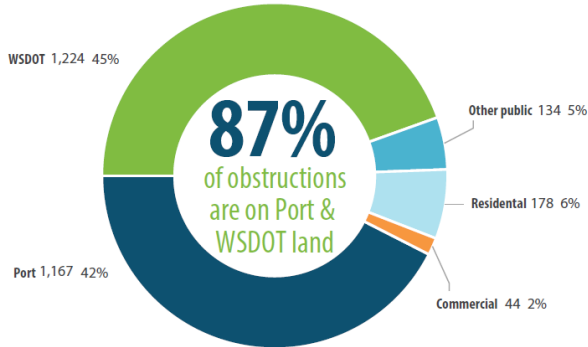


Structure, Scope and Develop Criteria

LOCATION OF OBSTRUCTIONS



- Principles: equity, metric-based and community engagement.
- Participatory models to inform and consult with community.
- Proposed model would:
 - Gather information from community and partner with stakeholders
 - Consult with Port of Seattle Internal Audit and CPO
 - Establish criteria, process and timelines
 - Brief and receive Commission feedback
 - Start application review and approval process

Inform, Consult and Involve

Community Partnerships

- Partners with third party group.
- Help expand reach, improve trust and target high-impact projects.
- Split funding model.



Robust Partnership to Expand Reach and Impact

Timeline

- Two-year engagement to align with Flight Corridor Safety Program.
- Twice-yearly disbursements.
- Report project status to Commission quarterly.
