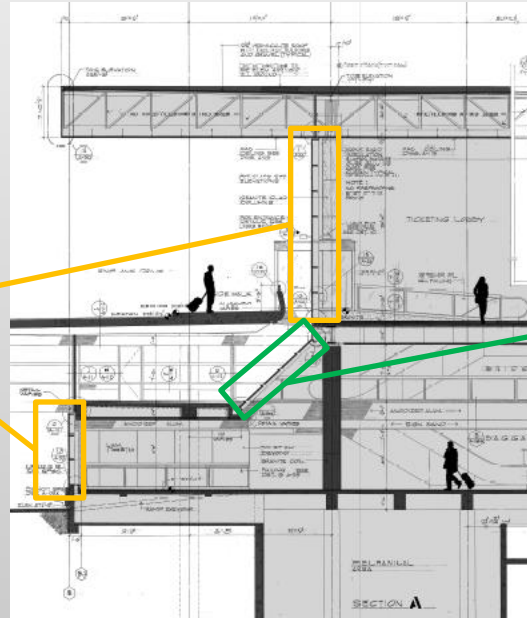

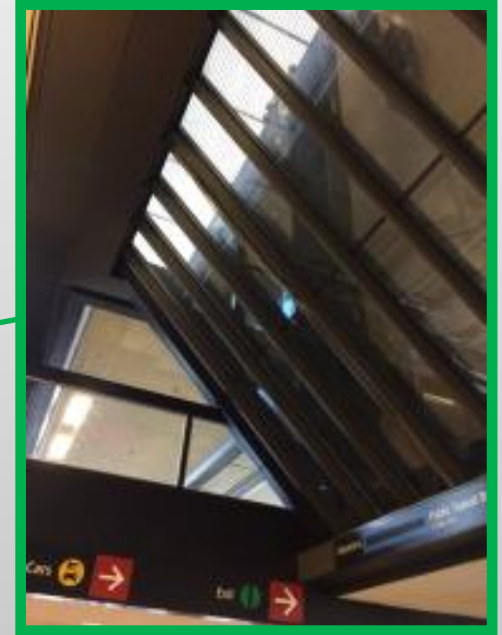

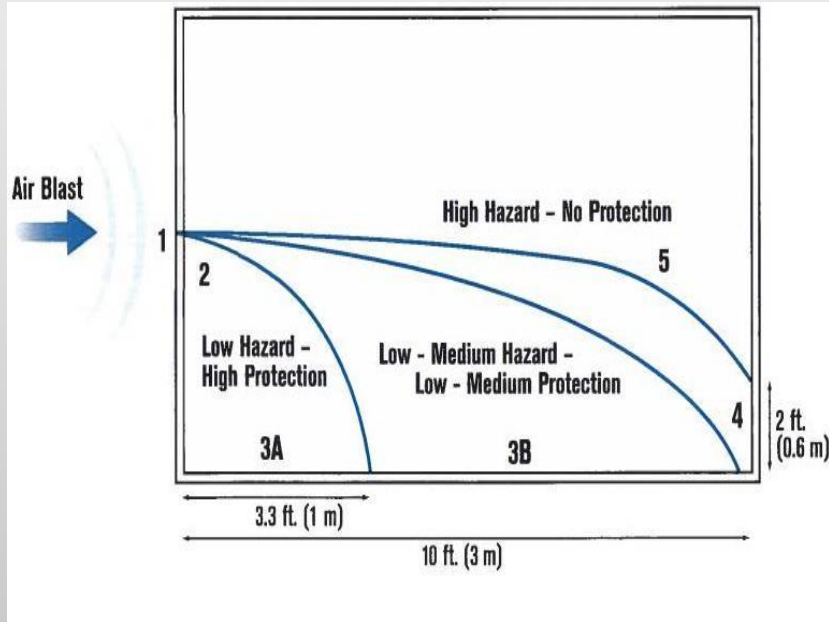
Main Terminal

Security Glazing Standards



Treatment Levels Considered:

- Level 1 (No hazard): Glazing will not crack or break.
- Level 2 (No hazard): Glazing will crack but no fragment penetration.
- Level 3A/3B (Very Low/Low hazard): Glazing will crack and fragments to penetrate 3.3 to 10 ft.
- Level 4 (Medium hazard): Glazing will crack and fragments will embed in back wall 10 ft back and 2 ft up.
- Level 5 (High hazard): Glazing will crack and fragments will embed in back wall 10 ft back and more than 2ft up.
