- Made major progress in Business Continuity Planning
- Created a 24/7 Duty Officer program at the Waterfront
- Re-wrote and have FAA acceptance of a new Airport Emergency Plan
- Emergency Procedures Booklet for Marine staff
- Conducted a Summit with City, County, State, and Federal (9) Partners
- Successfully conducted Triennial exercise with complements from the FAA
- Conducted the Aviation Security Tabletop and Airline Summit
- Conducted Emergency Preparedness Fairs for POS employees both Marine and Aviation

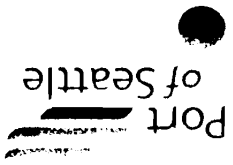
