- Expanded Preamble (Preamble)
- Additional procedures to fill a vacancy (Article II, Section 4)
- More detail on committee structure and functioning (Article II, Section 6)
- New clause on Port-related Board memberships (Article II, Section 7)

Port For Changes - Article IV:

- Work sessions eliminated (Art. IV)
- Time/Date of Meetings:
 1 p.m. on the 1st, 2nd and 4th Tuesdays
 (Art. IV, Section 1)
- Quarterly meetings outside the Port (Art. IV, Section 4)

of Seattle | Major Changes - Article | V:

- Transparency Code of Conduct incorporated into Bylaws (Art. IV, Section 6)
- Executive sessions limited to two per month (Art. IV, Section 6(B)
- Provision for meeting in absence of a quorum (Art. IV, Section 7)

of Seattle Major Changes - Article V-IX:

- Order of Business simplified (Art. V)
- Motions and Resolutions must be seconded (Art. VI, Section 2, Art. VII, Section 2)
- Commission Duties and Responsibilities (Art. IX)
