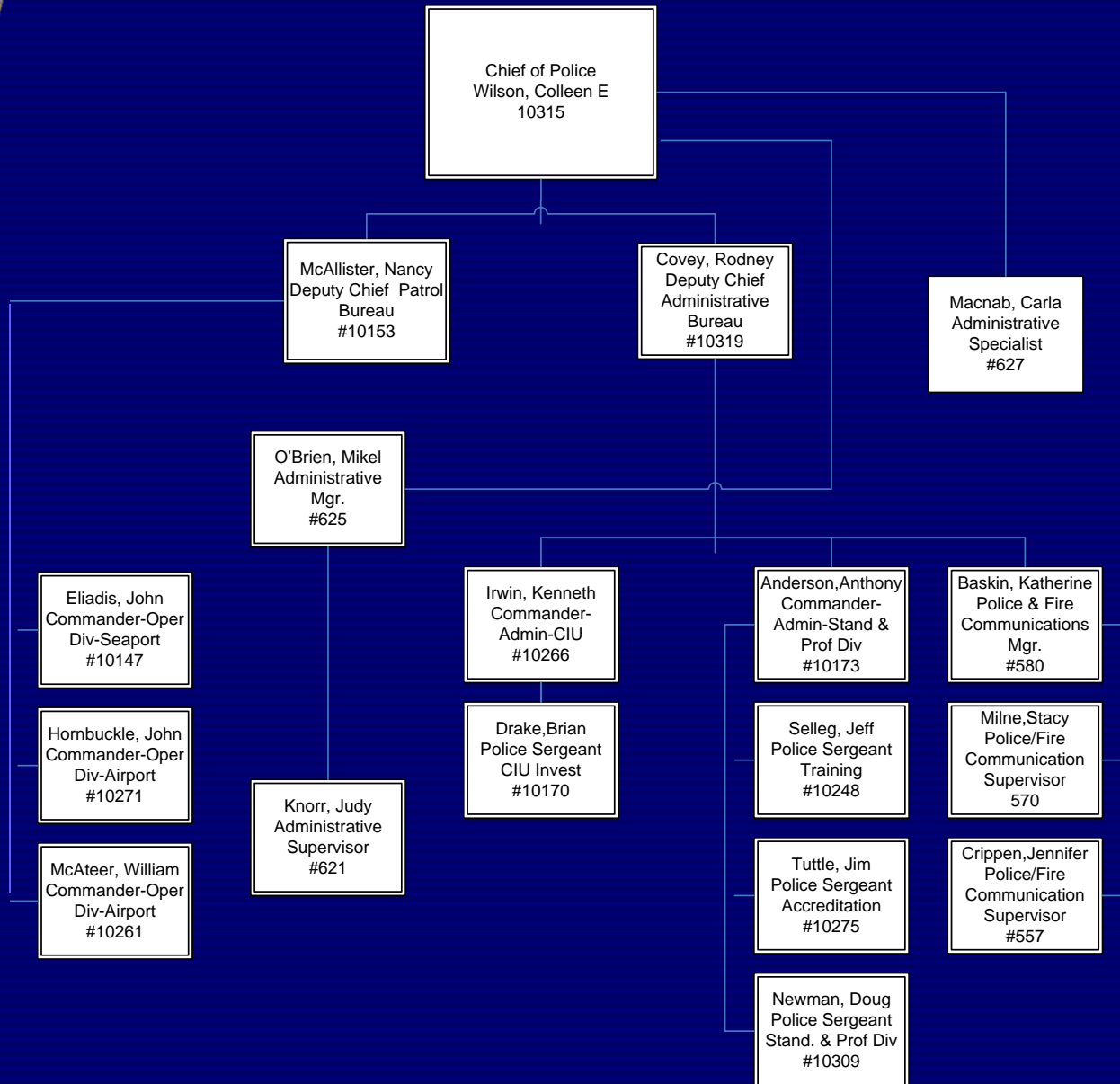

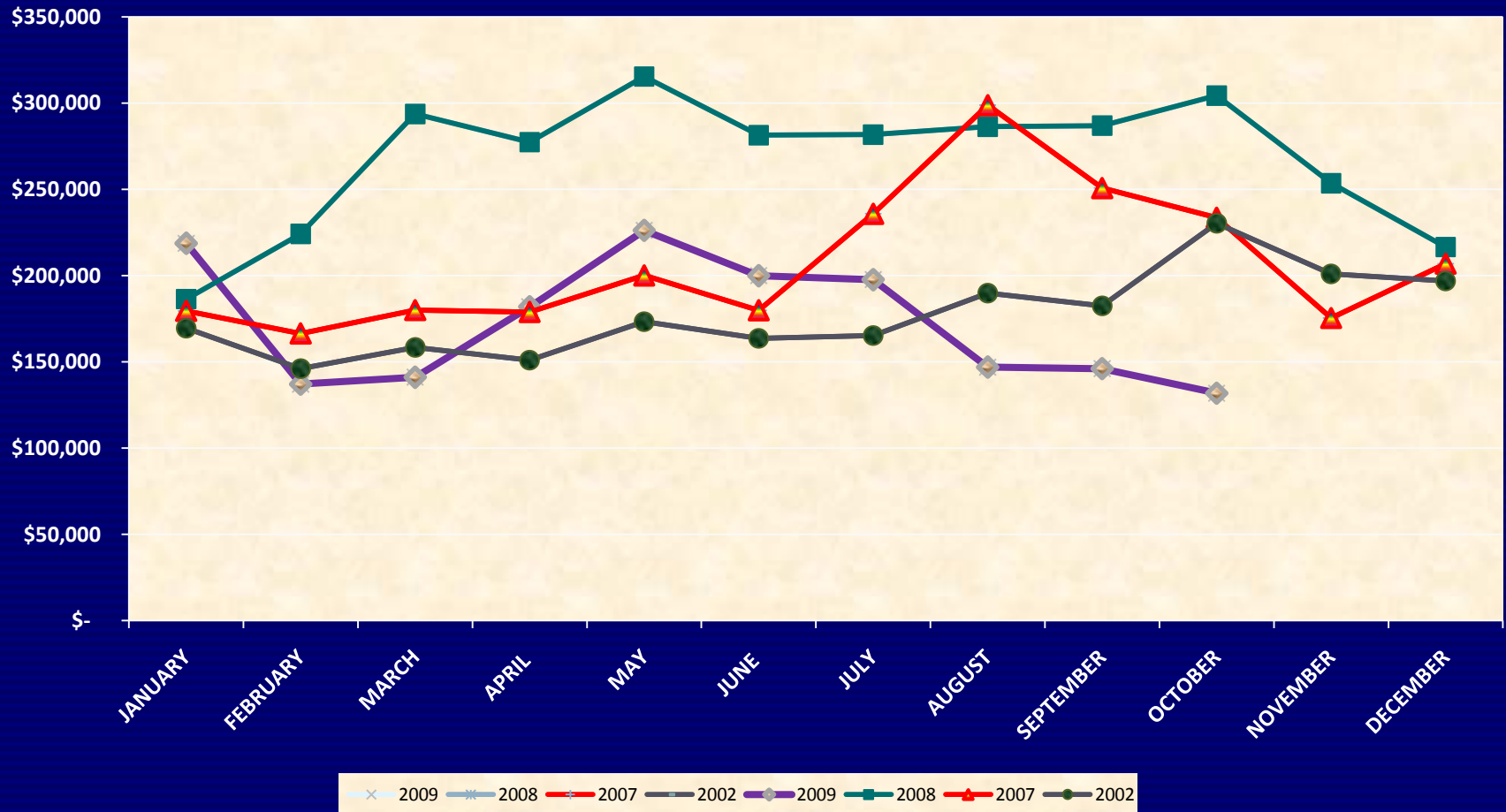


Reorganization
