





#### **Past work:**

- Century Agenda Panels (2008)
  - 4 panels divided by subject matter
  - led by one Senior Executive, one Commissioner
  - 4 meetings each panel, counting introductory group meeting
- Report on Guiding Principles (9/2009)
  - Shared Principles
  - Principles in each area
- Work since then (2010 present)
  - Formation of an ad hoc committee on the Century Agenda
  - Preliminary work on possible focus areas and panels





### Who, When, Outcomes

#### **Outcomes:**

- Integrate Century Agenda Recommendations in four areas with earlier strategic goals and other policy recommendations.
- Final product will be a list of 25-year Strategic Goals and 5-year milestones
- Subsequently, Port staff will create specific plans to reach 5-year milestones, to be approved by the Commission by December, 2011.

#### How:

- Led by Ad Hoc Committee of two Commissioners

- Panel Roundtables: external experts
- 6 panels divided by subject area that outlines issues, questions, disagreements in subject area
- Discussion with Port staff
- Outreach to the community
- Commission makes final decision




