## **BACKGROUND:**

The Port of Seattle had a very productive year in 2011, as evidenced by several major awards received in recognition of achievements in a number of areas. Particularly noteworthy were the awards for the port's environmental leadership, centennial products and financial reporting. In all, the port received 14 awards. Below is a brief summary of awards that deserve special attention, and a comprehensive list.
