

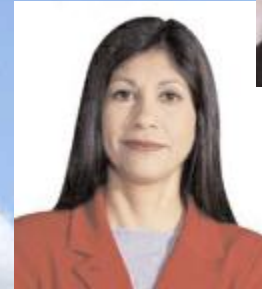

Tom Albro

Graduating from the University of Washington in 1985 with a BS in Civil Engineering, Tom Albro worked nights at United Parcel Service to put himself through school, then continued with UPS for several years before leaving for more entrepreneurial pursuits. He sold real estate until 1991, when he became a manager and eventually an owner of a construction firm in North Seattle. He founded Seattle Monorail Services, the private operator of the publicly-owned Seattle
