Given the complex nature of the port-related industries, the company could potentially engage in business with the Port, directly or indirectly.

Although it has been reported that Mr. Yoshitani followed Port policy and cleared this decision with the Port's general counsel, I believe that this decision needs more transparency and should be reviewed by the Port Commission in an open public meeting, in order to assure the public that no conflict of interest exists in this matter.
