Discover Kenmore's Natural Beauty

Enjoy miles of walking trails, bird watching, and play areas at a city park. To access the river and lake, use the public boat launch or docks to go boating, kayaking, standup paddle boarding, and fishing – or try a class at the Kenmore Waterfront Activities Center.



Trek the Burke-Gilman Trail

Move on this regional commuter and recreational trail linking Kenmore to Seattle. Or head east to connect with the Sammamish River Trail that leads to Kirkland, Bellevue, Redmond's Marymoor Park, and Issaquah.



Saint Edward State Park

The 300+ acre Saint Edward State Park is a heavily-forested asset with trails leading to Lake Washington, a whimsical playground, and playfields. It is the site of many concerts and festivals.

Saint Edward Seminary

The Saint Edward Seminary building is on the National Register of Historic Places and will soon be rehabilitated to offer lodging, dining and meeting space as the Lodge at Saint Edward.

Bastyr University is the largest natural health sciences university in North America, where you can tour the medicinal herb garden and reflexology path. The University Chapel is an acoustic gem used for recording sessions, performances and events.

- **Kenmore Air** features scheduled and chartered flights to the San Juan Islands and Canada from the largest air harbor in the U.S.
