

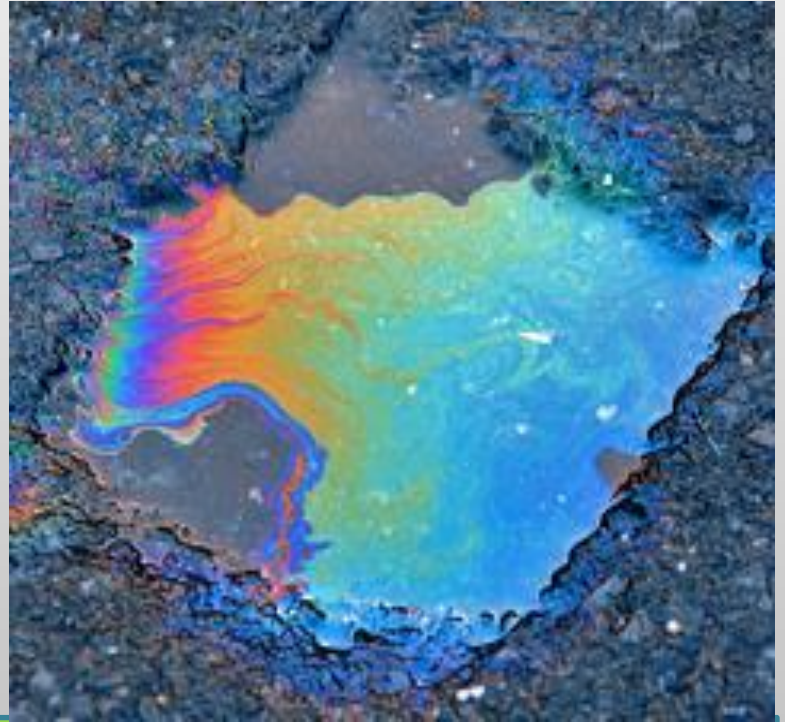
Illicit and Non-stormwater Discharge Policy

First Reading



Resolution No. 3596

- Established a policy prohibiting illicit and non-stormwater discharge through Maritime stormwater system
- Approved March 11, 2008
- Revised to incorporate City and State changes as of 2016



Last reviewed and approved in 2008

Revised Resolution No. 3750

- Meet requirements of state's municipal stormwater permit:
 - Implement policies prohibiting illicit and non-stormwater discharge
 - Ensure compliance with local regulations
- Updates:
 - References to current local and state regulations
 - Definitions for illicit connection, illicit discharge, and hazardous substance
 - Lists of 'fully prohibited,' 'conditionally allowable,' and 'permissible' discharges

Revise policy to reflect regulatory changes

Revised Resolution No. 3750

- Century Agenda Objective 14:
‘to meet or exceed agency requirements for stormwater leaving port-owned or operated facilities’
- Port’s stormwater program has consistently met the state’s municipal stormwater permit requirements and the city’s stormwater code
