## **LEED V4 Status Update**



#### **Current Status**

- On track to LEED V4 Silver certification 50 points
  - 49 points confirmed
    - 25 design points submitted
  - +2 "likely" materials points to be submitted at construction completion
  - +3 additional commissioning and air quality points being reviewed with Port stakeholders


#### **Highlights**

- Installing infrastructure for future rainwater reuse program (purple pipe)
- 90% of construction waste diverted from landfills
- Increased amount of daylight and views in non-regularly occupied spaces
- Increased use of low-emitting adhesives, paints, coatings, furniture, ceilings, walls, etc.




