
Zone 2 Ticket Counter Common Use Conversion



Project Scope and Budget


- Convert 6 ticket counter positions, currently being returned to the Port by United Airlines, into common use ticket counter positions in Zone 2.
- Install magnetic stanchions in the queueing area in front of the ticket counters.
- Install 4 common use kiosks.
- Install an overhead dynamic digital sign in the ticketing hall.

Total Project Cost: \$2,000,000 Design & Construction



RISK	DESCRIPTION	MITIGATION PLAN
United Airlines Tenant Expense/TRA Project taking place at the Zone 2 window wall	United Airlines reactivated the tenant expense/TRA window wall project in Zone 2.	Planning discussions have been initiated between both project teams.
	This project is anticipated to run concurrently with the Port Zone 2 Common Use Conversion Project.	Extensive coordination between the two projects will be required to mitigate operational impacts.
Aggressive Schedule	Project schedule is extremely aggressive to meet the goal of sponsor's preferred in- service goal of end of Q2 2022. No additional capacity in this schedule to accommodate unanticipated impacts or delays.	Project schedule will continue to be monitored and shared in coordination with project impacts.
Refurbishing Casework	Refurbishing of existing decommissioned casework will need to be brought to current ABD code and updated to best meet current aesthetic standards while staying within the project budget and schedule.	Coordination will continue throughout planning and design with ABD, PCS, design architect, stakeholders, and project team to address impacts and establish best practice.
