- Authorization to exempt this contract from a competitive process consistent with RCW 53.19.020
  - Salmon-Safe organization has the exclusive, peer-reviewed accreditation program in Washington, Oregon, California, and British Columbia.
- Execute contract(s) with Salmon-Safe, a non-profit organization, for a not to exceed amount of \$200,000, for the Port's Salmon-safe certification.
  - Requested contract(s) authorization provides flexibility to have option years and continue the Salmon Safe certification for the next four cycles (20 years).
