SEA Rental Car Operations

Rental Car Facility (RCF) began operation in May 2012

- Lease between the Port and the rental car industry (30-year term)
- Concession Agreement component expires in May 2027 (10-year term plus 5-year Covid-related extension)

Rental car operations a significant non-aeronautical revenue source

- 4.6 million passengers rented cars in 2023
- \$46.5 million in concession/land rent revenues
- \$41.6 million in customer facility charge revenues

Project Purpose and Scope

Purpose:

Support the re-bidding of the RCF Concession Agreement and improve the customer experience

Scope of Work:

- Improvements to define tenant operational blocks (interior walls/finishes, HVAC, lighting, utilities, signage)
- Remodel customer service building restrooms
- Other renewal/replacement scope as required

Project Budget and Schedule

Current Est. Budget: \$10,545,410

This Request: \$2,000,000


Project scope not fully defined – additional budget may be required
